

CHAPEL GLEN CLUB, INC. SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations of the Chapel Glen Pool area established to promote water safety, to provide a clean, healthful swimming environment and to comply with rules and regulations of the Marion county Board of Health. Lifeguards are on duty at all times that the pool is open to general use. The primary duties of the lifeguards are the maintenance of a safe, orderly swimming pool, and swimmer assistance and rescue.

1. The pool area includes the swimming pools, fence and all area within the fence.
2. All persons using the pool area do so at their own risk and responsibility.
3. The lifeguards are responsible for strict enforcement of all rules and regulations. Lifeguards are authorized to revoke a patrons pool privileges for infractions of the rules. The length of time will depend on the severity of the infraction.
4. No person will be in the pool without a lifeguard on duty.
5. Any homeowner in disagreement with the rulings or conduct of a lifeguard should bring these complaints to the attention of the Pool Manager. If this action is still unsatisfactory, the homeowner should contact a member of the Pool Committee. Telephone numbers are listed in the Chapel Glen Directory, and at the Pool.
6. No food, smoking, alcoholic beverages, gum, or glass bottles or containers are permitted in the pool area. The Marion County Board of Health regulates and enforces these restrictions.
7. No pets are permitted in the pool area.
8. Running, boisterous or rough play, or foul or abusive language is not permitted in the pool area.
9. Toys designed for water use are permitted at the discretion of the acting manager.
10. Tricycles, wagons or any other wheeled vehicles are prohibited within the pool area.
11. Only one person at a time is permitted on the diving board. Divers must enter the water in front of the boards and not jump toward the walls or ladders. The diving board may be closed at the discretion of the lifeguards when safety and enjoyment of pool facilities by members or their guests are in any jeopardy. The diving board is always closed when there is not a guard present. No inward or reverse dives allowed.
12. Children under the age of 9 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult or responsible person over the age of 14.
13. Children under the age of 12 will be given a swimming test to allow the lifeguards to assess their abilities. Children who cannot pass the swimming test will not be allowed in the diving area unless supervised by a parent and approved by the managing lifeguard.
14. Street clothing or cut-offs are not allowed in the pool area except for persons who are accompanying and supervising children in the pool or attending an authorized event. Only swim suits are allowed in the pool.

15. The pool will be cleared of all persons under 18 years of age each hour, for 10 minutes, for an adult swim. At least one guard will remain on duty during this time. Depending on the patron load, the pool manager may elect not to call an adult swim.
16. All persons using the main pool are cautioned to be aware of the depth of the water before entering the pool. Water depth varies from 2.5 to 3.5 feet in the shallow portion, 3.5 to 5 feet in the main portion, and is 10 feet in the diving well.
17. All persons having infectious or communicable disease shall be excluded from the swimming pool area. Persons having any open blisters, cuts, etc., shall be warned that these are likely to become infected and advised not to use the pool.
18. The baby pool is intended for the use of children under the age of 6.
19. No somersaults or back dives from the edge of the pool.
20. Pool phone is for emergency use only.
21. In order to maintain a safe environment, and provide accountability, lifeguards will require all persons using the swimming facilities to display their pool badge each day to the lifeguards to identify themselves as Chapel Glen Club members.
22. A daily guest pass must be purchased for each guest. A weekly guest pass may be purchased for out of town family members. A Chapel Glen Club member 18 years or older must be responsible for obtaining guests' badges.
23. There is no charge for grandchildren of homeowners to use the pool facilities. Those using the pool on a regular basis will need to have their own pool badge.
24. Chapel Glen Club members may purchase a summer family pass for their adult children who do not live in Chapel Glen but visit on a regular basis. A Chapel Glen Club member may also purchase a summer pass for a baby-sitter who brings members' children to the pool.

The pool will generally be closed when the air temperature is less than 70 degrees. During rainy periods, the pool will open as follows:

6:00 PM	Closed for the day

Any time there is a potential lightning threat, the pool will be cleared immediately, with all persons leaving the fenced area. The pool area will reopen when there has been no lightning observed for 30 minutes or at the discretion of the pool manager.
